

Dr. Veronique Inès Thouvenot is Co-founder and Scientific Director at the Millennia2025 Foundation. She is a recognized e-Health and Telemedicine senior expert, Head of WeTelemed and “Women and eHealth” International Working Group, with extensive experience in evaluation, scientific analysis and technical assistance in e-Health, e-Learning, Telemedicine and Gender projects in developing countries. During the last 15 years, she has conducted several field missions to evaluate the impact of the use of ICTs for epidemiological surveillance, maternal and child health, tuberculosis, leishmaniasis, yellow fever, Buruli ulcer, HIV and malaria in DRC, Congo, Senegal, Venezuela, Madagascar, Morocco and Jordan.

She worked at UN agencies, the International Telecommunication Union in Geneva as eHealth Advisor, and at the World Health Organization as scientist in the eHealth unit. Previously, she was researcher and evaluation officer at the European Center of Humanitarian Health. She coordinates and organizes eHealth and telemedicine trainings, international conferences, is invited to speak in high level events and contributes to numerous publications.

She holds a doctorate in Advanced Mathematics and Decision Support Systems in Humanitarian and Public Health, an MBA in Project Management, and post graduate diplomas in Medical Law and Health Economy from the University of Medicine in Lyon, France.
